Repairs, Refurbishment and Maintenance

- Restoration and repairs of holy water stoups
- Altar furniture overhauled and restored with new fabric
- Moth treatment of carpet
- Scaffolding for roof work and down pipes acquired and put in practice
- Restoration and rehangng of large mahogany doors from the Chapel into the Sacristy
- Vestment repairs
- New microphones bought
- Candelabra restored
- Repairs to silverware

Future Work

- There is concern about plaster deterioration in the domed ceiling above the altar. It is proposed that a survey is done to investigate the integrity of this plasterwork

Events over the year

- We celebrated our Patronal Feast Day, All Saints' Day 2020, with Mass celebrated by a re3tired Bishop of Northampton, Bishop Peter Doyle
- Covid restrictions have limited many events. However, weddings and funerals have taken place. The First Holy Communion Service went ahead as normal
- Most recitals later on in the year were cancelled due to Covid restrictions however weekly masses, when permitted, went ahead and we also opened up the Chapel for private prayer
- Wardour School, our local primary school, continues to make us of the Chapel for Mass
