When we have received this form we will:-

- 1) check with our insurance company that you will be covered
- 2) arrange for two of our members to visit you at your home, to get to know you a bit and to verify the copy of your driving license
- 3) invite you to one of our regular meetings for an introduction
- 4) ask you to pay the re-fundable deposit and set up a standing order for the monthly fee
- 5) arrange an introduction session for the use of our vehicle (e.g. how to use the automatic gear shift, how to top up oil and water, how to obtain the key, how to book the vehicle over the Internet)

Please allow one month for this process to be completed.

Conditions under which insurance will be provided

Insurance will be provided only on condition that:-

- 1) the policyholder (hOURCARS) will verify the address of the member
- 2) the original driving licence of the member is inspected by the policyholder
- 3) the car will not be hired to nor driven by a 'driver not insured' as described below:-
 - (a) Provisional licence holders.
 - (b) Drivers who have held a full driving licence for less than 12 months for the class of vehicle being hired.
 - (c) Drivers aged 20 or under
 - (d) Drivers aged 24 or under when the vehicle being hired has a seating capacity of nine or more, in addition to the driver's seat.
 - (e) Professional sportspersons.
 - (f) Members of the entertainment profession.
 - (g) Models.
 - (h) Itinerant workers.
 - (i) Drivers who have been disqualified for a period exceeding six months in the last three years and drivers who have been disqualified for a period exceeding three months during the past year.
 - (j) Any person not disclosed on the hirer driving declaration
 - (k) Drivers involved in more than three accidents in the last three years.
 - (l) Drivers with more than two theft claims in the last three years.

Drivers with the following convictions on their licences cannot be insured: UT50; CD40; CD50; CD60; CD70; CD71; DD40; DD60; DD80; DR10; DR20; DR30; DR31; DR40; DR50; DR60; DR61; DR70; DR80 or DR90.

hOURCARS must ensure that a driver has notified DVLA at Swansea of any disability or disease and that a licence has been issued, or not revoked.

Medical conditions which should be notified to DVLA are:-

- An epileptic event
- Sudden attacks of disabling giddiness, fainting or blackouts
- Severe mental handicap
- A pacemaker, defibrillator or anti-ventricular tachycardia device fitted
- Diabetes controlled by insulin or tablets
- Angina (heart pain) whilst driving
- Multiple sclerosis
- Parkinsons disease
- Any other chronic neurological condition
- A serious problem with memory
- A serious problem with confusion
- A major or minor stroke
- Any type of brain surgery, brain tumour or severe head injury involving hospital in-patient treatment
- Any severe psychiatric illness or mental disorder
- Continuing / permanent difficulty in the use of arms or legs which affects ability to control a vehicle safely
Dependence on or misuse of alcohol, illicit drugs or chemical substances in the past 3 years - this does not include drink/driving offences
- Any visual disability which affects BOTH eyes - it is not necessary to declare short/long sight or colour blindness.
